It was read at her funeral years later.

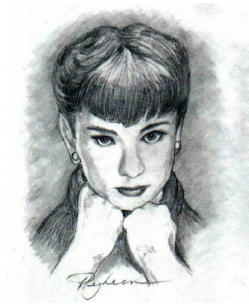


For attractive lips, speak words of kindness.
